The instant petitions have been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0123 dated 10.12.2020 under Sections 406 and 498A IPC registered at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that a matrimonial dispute had arose between the parties, however the matter stands settled amicably and a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has already been filed. It is further submitted that pursuant to the settlement, a quashing petition numbered as CRM-M-27319 of 2021 stands filed and fixed for hearing on 13.01.2022.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have perused the interim orders wherein the arrest of the petitioner had been stayed taking into account that the petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, had been filed.

Now consequent to the fact that the matter has been settled and the quashing petition has been filed based on the said settlement, this court deems it appropriate to confirm the order of staying the arrest of the petitioner.

The petition is allowed accordingly. The order of stay of arrest of the petitioner dated 19.02.2021 is confirmed subject to the terms as contained under Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.
