Petitioners have filed this writ petition under Articles 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 and 5 as they have solemnized marriage on 16.02.2021 against their wishes.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of U.T.Chandigarh has produced the statement of petitioner No.2, wherein he has stated that he is not facing any threat from the private respondents. Statements of private respondent Nos.4 and 5 have also been recorded, who stated that they have no objection to the alleged marriage of the petitioners.
