The grievance of the petitioners is that despite being at par with ministerial staff, they are not being paid grade pay of Rs. 6600/- and secretariat allowance of Rs. 2500/- as is being paid to the ministerial staff vide circular dated 09.05.2014 (Annexure P-5). Numerous representations have been submitted but to no effect. The last representation is dated 02.05.2019 and a copy thereof is Annexure P-12 on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the Vice Chancellor of the University may be directed to dispose of the representation dated 02.05.2019 (Annexure P-12), by passing a speaking order within a limited time frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Govind Goyal, Advocate and Mr. Rahul Rana, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed there is no necessity of filing a written statement.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 1 to decide the pending representation dated 02.05.2019 (Annexure P-12) in accordance with rules on the subject and by passing a speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
