1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.41 dated 19.01.2021 at Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal, under Section 307 IPC and under Section 25 of the Arms Act.
2. The FIR in question was lodged at the instance of Prem Singh, wherein it is alleged that on 19.01.2021 his nephew Sunny had fired at him with a gun with an intention to kill him. However, no injury was caused to anybody.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the FIR came to be lodged due to some misunderstanding and that the said misunderstanding has been cleared and the matter has been

amicably resolved amongst the accused and the complainant, who are closely related.

4. While the learned State counsel has opposed the petition, but Mr. H.S.Jugait, Advocate, appearing on behalf of the complainant, has endorsed the factum of compromise and has categorically stated that since the petitioner happens to be the nephew of the complainant and that the matter has been amicably resolved, he has no objection for grant of bail to the petitioner.
5. In view of the aforestated position, wherein the parties are closely related and have amicably resolved their issues and while also noticing the fact that nobody has been injured in the incident, the petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
