ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to decide representations dated 01.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) and dated 13.02.2021 (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner for taking action against respondent Nos.4 to 6.

A perusal of the petition shows that petitioner is an Ex-Sarpanch of the village and respondent No.6 is also an Ex-Sarpanch of the village, who, while doing some development work, has laid down sewerage pipelines in the village for draining the water. The only grievance of the petitioner is that due to personal enmity, sewerage pipes have been laid just adjoining the wall of the house of the petitioner and despite the efforts made by the petitioner, the same has not been removed. In that process, some complaints have also been given to the police against respondent No.6.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, it is found that apparently it is a case of civil dispute regarding removal of some sewerage

pipelines for which, the petitioner has efficacious remedy of filing a suit for mandatory injunction.

In view of the above, no merit is found in the present petition and the same is dismissed.
