Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release the detenu from the illegal custody of respondents No.4 and 5.

Vide order dated 10.3.2021, this Court directed Area Magistrate to submit a report with regard to the identity and state of mind of detenu.

In compliance of the said order, report of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala was received vide which it has been recorded that from the questions put to the detenu and the Aadhar Card produced, the detenu was identified as Bhupinder Singh and was found capable of taking decisions of his own. It has been further mentioned that he wanted to stay with his father Kewal Singh, wife Mandeep Kaur and daughter Bismanpreet Kaur at House No.B-49/877, Mann Nagar, Dera Baba Nanak Road, Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has instructions to withdraw the petition.
