Application disposed of

Main case

Grievance raised in the instant petition is that the electricity connection installed in the house of the petitioner who happens to be a lady and a senior citizen has been disconnected abruptly and without any justifiable basis.

Counsel submits that all the bills raised pertaining to the electricity connection were duly paid. The officials of powercom, Patiala, have taken

such coercive step at the instance of private respondent No.3 with whom there is a ongoing property dispute.

Having heard counsel at length and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the second respondent i.e. Managing Director, Powercom, PSEB, Head Office, The Mall, Patiala, Punjab, to examine the grievance of the petitioner against the backdrop of a representation dated 03.02.2021 (Annexure P-4) and to thereafter take steps as deemed fit and warranted in accordance with law.
