Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.103 dated 19.06.2019 under Sections 307/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered on the statement of Gurmeet Singh, he was having illicit relations with wife of the petitioner Raj Rani for the last five years and now Raj Rani has started avoiding him. It is further stated that on the date of incident, the complainant was having drink and the petitioner along with one Moshan @

Govind Singh had sprinkled some oil on his back and set him on fire. It is further submitted that co-accused of the petitioner Govind Singh @ Moshan has already been granted the concession of regular bail by the trial Court vide order dated 09.09.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case, as it is own case of the complainant that he was having illicit relations with wife of the petitioner and by creating some evidence, he has tried to involve the petitioner in this case in order to put pressure on his wife Raj Rani.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated 04.03.2021 in the Court today and as per this custody certificate, the petitioner is in custody for the last 03 months and 15 days and is not involved in any other case and challan already stands presented.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition stands disposed of.
