Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 40 dated 16.01.2020, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506, 341 and 325 of the IPC at Police Station Surajkund, District Faridabad.

The operative part of the order dated 12.02.2020, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that it is a case of versions and cross-version and as per the allegations in the FIR, on account of a sudden provocation, the incident has taken place.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that even from the petitioners' side, four persons have received injuries.

Notice of motion for 16.04.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 12.02.2020, have already appeared before

the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sajid Hussain, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 12.02.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
