The petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty, as they apprehend danger from respondents No.4 and 5, who are against the marriage of the petitioners.

On 22.2.2021, learned State counsel sought time to verify the existence of alleged threat.

Today, learned State counsel has produced the copy of respective statements of the petitioners wherein as per the stand of the official respondents, statement of the petitioner No.1 was recorded on 15.4.2021 wherein she stated that she and her husband do not apprehend any danger. Statements of respondents No.4 and 5 have also been recorded wherein they have stated that they have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners and they will not interfere.

In view of the above, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
