Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.29 dated 20.01.2020, registered under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 of IPC, 1860, at Police Station Quilla Panipat, District Panipat.

On 20.02.2020, this Court while granting interim protection to the petitioners, passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that Sunil @ Sheela has been attributed with an injury inflicted on the chest of the son of the complainant by a sharp edged weapon. Petitioner No.2-Sompal @ Soma has been attributed with the blow of 'Binda' on the son of the complainant. Counsel has further submitted that marriage of petitioner No.1 is fixed on 28.02.2020 and the ceremonies for the marriage are fixed on 27.02.2020 and 28.02.2020.

Learned State counsel has filed affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Head Quarter, Panipat, whereby factum of marriage of petitioner No.1 has been verified. Learned State counsel, upon instructions of ASI Parveen Kumar, has submitted that the medical summary of the injuries inflicted on the son of the complainant is awaited. He has further submitted that even the sharp edged weapon used by petitioner No.1 is yet to be recovered.

Adjourned to 27.03.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Upon instructions from HC Sanjiv Kumar, State counsel submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no longer required for custodial interrogation. He has further instructions to state that the petitioners are not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 20.02.2020, granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
