On 24.08.2021, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This petition has been filed by the wife seeking the transfer of the petition filed under Section 6 read with Section 25 of the Guardians & Wards Act, 1890, titled as 'Sumit Mahajan vs. Charu Mahajan' pending in the Family Court, Ludhiana to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Chandigarh.

The petitioner claims that she got married to the respondent on 10.01.2018. She claims that at present, she alongwith her minor child, is residing with her parents at Chandigarh and cannot properly defend the petition at Ludhiana.

Notice of motion for 09.09.2021.

The liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve the respondent through his counsel Sh. Iqbal Singh, District Court, Ludhiana.

As per the office report, the notice issued to the respondent has been received back served, however, he remains unrepresented.

In view of the facts noticed in the order dated 24.08.2021, the transfer application is allowed. It is directed that the proceedings in petition filed Section 6 read with Section 25 of the Guardians & Wards Act, 1890, titled as 'Sumit Mahajan vs. Charu Mahajan' pending in the Family Court, Ludhiana be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Chandigarh. The transferor court is directed to remit the file of the case to the transferee court forthwith. The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the District & Sessions Judge, Chandigarh on 30.09.2021, who shall either try the case himself or assign the same to the court of competent jurisdiction in the District.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
