Prayer in this petition is for protection of lives and liberties of the petitioners from being invaded by some private persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.3 is husband of petitioner No.1. Petitioner No.2 is the daughter of petitioners No.1 and 3. Petitioner No.2 is married to Chand Singh. Petitioner No.3 is the Head of Gurudwara Sahib in the village. Due to some rivalry in the village, the opposite party is in search of appropriate opportunity to implicate the petitioners.

Chand Singh has been falsely implicated in FIR No.99 dated 15.12.2020 under Sections 15/61/85 of NDPS Act,

Police Station Badhani Kalan, District Moga. Chand Singh has already filed a representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga in respect of his false implication. In CRM-M No.2798 of 2020, arrest of Chand Singh has been stayed by the High Court vide order dated 21.01.2021 and said petition is fixed for 24.03.2021.

Learned counsel further submits that since Chand Singh is pursuing his representation before the authorities, therefore, the authorities have pressurized the petitioners not to allow Chand Singh to pursue his remedies.

Precisely in the context of prayer made by the petitioners, they have also ventured to make a representation to the Chief Justice of Punjab and Haryana High Court.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amar Ashok Pathak, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling upon any response as no order prejudicial to interest of any party is being passed.

This petition is disposed with a direction to respondent No.2 to have a fair glance upon the grievance of the petitioners forming subject matter of representation dated 19.12.2020, within a period of one month from the date of

receipt of certified copy of this order, without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.
