This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.3 to put up the case before an appropriate authority and pass order for release of the petitioner as per the provisions of law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3-Superintendent, Central Jail, Ludhiana to consider and decide the representation dated 24.10.2020 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously.
