Vide this petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., the petitioner prays for an anticipatory bail in FIR No.0165, dated 09.07.2019, under Sections 323, 324 and 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court vide order dated 12.02.2020 had released the petitioner on interim bail:

“Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits *inter alia* that the petitioner is a woman and no grievous injury on the victim is attributed to him in the FIR.

Notice of motion for 07.05.2020.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting/Investigating Officer, she shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That she shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;

2. That she shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer and;

3. That she shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gurmukh Singh, submits that pursuant to order dated 12.02.2020 (ibid), the petitioner had joined the investigation and is no longer required for any custodial interrogation.

In the wake of the above, the order dated 12.02.2020, which was passed over year and half ago, is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
