AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This is a petition seeking directions to the official respondents to take action upon the representation dated 9.1.2021 made by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the representation is pending for the last more than one month but no action has been taken.

Learned counsel for the State appearing on advance notice submits that the matter is being enquired into and the parties were called for recording their statements but they never turned up.

From the perusal of the representation, it is evident that the dispute is with regard to succession of moveable and immoveable properties of Gian Chand. The relevant paragraph of the representation is

quoted below:

“7. That the death of my husband, abovesaid Piyush Gupta and Alka Gupta got lodged on false DDR No. 031 dated 27.11.2020 at Police Station Division E, Amritsar, in which it has been written that the keys of all lockers, FDRs and original pass books of saving accounts have been misplaced, which is totally false. The abovesaid accused under the planned conspiracy has misled the police and has also misled the banks and tried to open many the lockers and they have got opened many lockers. Along with this accused have committed fraud with us. Copy of DDR is enclosed.”

The tone and tenor of the allegations are of civil dispute, in such circumstances, no case is made out for interference by this Court.

The petition is dismissed.
