1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the Contempt Petition was filed for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 14.11.2019, in CWP-30415-2019, whereby the respondents had been directed to decide the representations dated 26.09.2016 and 19.12.2018, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, but, copy of order dated 04.12.2020, passed by the respondents in terms of order dated 14.11.2019, in CWP-30415-2019, has been supplied to him, rejecting the claim made in representations dated 26.09.2016 and 19.12.2018 and that in the circumstances, he does not press the Contempt Petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 04.12.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

3. Order dated 04.12.2020 is taken on record.

4. In view of the position as noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the Contempt Petition is dismissed as

withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
