The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.43 dated 01.02.2021 registered under Sections 323 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station City, District Kaithal.

The operative part of the order dated 23.02.2021, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 17.02.2021 passed in this Court in **CRM-M-7420-2021** titled as **Reena Sharma and another Versus Stte of Haryana**.*

Notice of motion.

*Be listed along with **CRM-M-7420 of 2021** on 21.05.2021.*

Interim order in the same terms.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 23.02.2021, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Vijay Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 23.02.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
