Case has been called out twice. Learned counsel representing the petitioner has not come forward to press this petition.

This Court has gone through the paper book. It is pleaded that the disciplinary proceedings are pending against the petitioner. He prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to supply the complete information demanded by him through his e-mail (Annexure P-6). It has been noticed that the petitioner himself has pleaded that he was permitted to inspect the record. However, he alleges that the record was not complete.

Once the disciplinary proceedings are pending against the petitioner, this Court does not find it appropriate to issue any directions at this stage. Hence, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order, if any, passed against him.

With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.
