The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.327 dated 16.05.2018 registered under Sections 323/324/506/302/34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, district Jhajjar.

After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the present petition on its merits and he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Trial Court to dispose of the petitioner's trial in a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel submits that he has no objection if the above alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted.

For the reason that every undertrial has a right to a speedy trial and because the petitioner is in custody for the last over three and a half years as also because only seven prosecution witnesses remain to be

examined in the petitioner's trial wherein he is being prosecuted for murder, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to dispose of the petitioner's trial within four months from the next date fixed before it in accordance with law, of course, subject to the petitioner's and his counsel's cooperation.
