The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This petition is filed for issuance of directions to the official respondents to decide the representation dated 22.12.2020 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners.

Notice of motion was issued on 23.2.2021. It was directed that the police officials not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police should record the statements of the petitioner.

On 5.3.2021, the Court was informed that the representation was never received by the official respondents and the petitioners have refused to stay in the safe house. However, it was stated that proceedings under Sections 107 and 151 Cr.P.C. have been initiated against the husband of petitioner No.1 and his brother and relatives including his mother.

Print out of reply dated 3.3.2021 filed by the State through electronic media is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are satisfied with steps taken by police and no cause of action survives to pursue the present petition.

The petition is disposed of as infructuous.

However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case cause of action so arises.
