The petitioner is seeking a direction to the trial Court to decide the application against the attachment of the bank account of the petitioner/Trust in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the application has been filed by the petitioner/trust on 23.07.2019 (Annexure P-5) and has not been decided so far. He also contends that the petitioner is a charitable trust and due to attachment of the bank account, the working of the trust has come to a standstill.

Heard through video conferencing.

Due to COVID-19 pandemic, there is limited functioning of the Court and it would be difficult to issue a direction to the trial Court to decide the application expeditiously.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that whenever the normal physical functioning of the Courts resumes, the trial Court be directed to take up the application and decide the same expeditiously.

Consequently, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to the trial Court that on the resumption of physical working of the Court after normalcy in situation, the application would be taken up and decided in accordance with law expeditiously.
