Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail, pending trial in case FIR No.34 dated 30.06.2019, under Section 22 N.D.P.S.Act, 1985 and Section 29 N.D.P.S.Act (added later on), registered at Police Station, Singh Bhagwantpura, District Rupnagar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sohan Singh, has stated that out of sixteen prosecution witnesses, eight have already been examined and four have been given up. According to him, two witnesses have been summoned for recording their evidence before the trial court today.

Considering the above stand of the learned State counsel, this court is not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.
