The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 14 dated 15.01.2020, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner has taken a sum of ₹1,82,000/- from the complainant on the pretext of sending his wife abroad, but she was not sent despite payment.

On 23.12.2021, learned counsel for the petitioner had contended that the petitioner is willing to settle the matter with the complainant and had sought some time in this regard. On 27.09.2021, learned counsel contended that the matter had been settled with the complainant and had sought time to place on record an affidavit of the complainant or the deed of settlement. The petitioner had also been directed to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on *ad interim* bail.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gyan Singh, contends that neither the petitioner has joined investigation nor there is any document with regard to the matter having been compromised.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has not furnished any settlement deed and therefore, requests for withdrawal of this petition at this stage.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
