ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.03 dated 07.01.2021, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act (Offences under Sections 326 and 325 IPC added subsequently), registered at Police Station City Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury which has been attributed to the petitioner falls within purview of Section 325 IPC.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Sukhdev Singh contends that in the incident two persons were brutally injured and they received 14 injuries, including several fractures. He further contends that the petitioner is also involved in another case.

Heard.

The petitioner is alleged to have caused a datar blow on the left elbow of the injured. The petitioner and other co-accused had brutally attacked the injured who had received several injuries including fractures. The first petition bearing CRM-M-6645-2021 was dismissed as withdrawn on 12.02.2021. Therefore, I do not intend to take another view in the matter.

The petition stands dismissed.
