The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.15 dated 22.01.2021, under Sections 420, 408, 201 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations are with regard to the misappropriation of funds but the petitioner has been falsely implicated as he is the son of Rajesh Bansal, who was a business partner of the complainant and there was a dispute between the two with regard to business transactions.

This Court, by the order dated 15.03.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Atma Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 15.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
