The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

Petitioner-Sukhvir Kaur stated to be aged 40 years has filed the present civil revision petition *inter alia* with a prayer for directing the Executing Court (MACT SBS Nagar) to expeditiously issue payment vouchers to the petitioner in Execution No.24 of 2020 decided on 12.12.2020 in the National Lok Adalat (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner draws attention of this Court to the judgment dated 22.01.2018 passed by this Court in FAO No.9593 of 2014 filed by the petitioner and others vide which the award of the Tribunal was modified and the compensation allowed to the appellants-claimants was ordered to be enhanced from Rs.36,81,840/- to Rs.53,78,590/- for the death of Amarjeet Singh. Learned counsel then makes reference to order dated 12.12.2020 passed by the ld. Additional Sessions Judge, SBS Nagar, whereby the execution filed by the petitioner, was dismissed as withdrawn being fully satisfied. The positive case of the petitioner is that the said

Adalat as fully satisfied. He, however, submits by making reference to para 6 of the petition that despite this, no amount has been released by the Executing Court. The payment vouchers are kept pending for more than two months now.

In the peculiar facts and circumstances noticed above, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition and without commenting on the merits of the case, it is directed as under:-

- (i) the petitioner shall move an application stating out the entire claim of the petitioner which is still pending. The petitioner may also state in the application the prayers that has been mentioned in the present revision petition.
- (ii) The Executing Court is directed to examine the application so filed and dispose of the same *de hors* the order dated 12.12.2020 referred to above.
