Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.17 dated 19.01.2020 registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Vide order dated 12.02.2020 passed by a co-ordinate bench of this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.
