GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

Petitioner No.1, namely, Anjali aged about 19 years and petitioner No.2 Prince aged about 18 years have approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction to official respondents to protect their lives and liberty as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of private respondents, who do not approve live-in relationship of the petitioners.

It is the case of the petitioners that they are fond of each other and will solemnize marriage as and when petitioner No.2 attains the age of majority, but their relationship is strongly objected to by the parents and relatives of petitioner No.1.

Without commenting as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Ambala to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 22.02.2021 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law. In case, it is found that there is a

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genuine threat to the lives and liberty of the petitioners, then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

A copy of this order alongwith copy of the representation dated 22.02.2021 be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Ambala (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

It is, however, clarified that the aforesaid order shall not confer any immunity upon the petitioners, in case it is found that they have committed any wrong.
