The petitioner has filed this petition for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order/proceedings uploaded on 21.08.2020 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.3 whereby the technical bid of the petitioner has been illegally rejected and that of respondent No.4 has been accepted. The petitioner has also prayed for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the first appeal dated 09.09.2020 (Annexure P-3) filed by him in a time bound manner which has not been decided as yet.

Learned Deputy Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Punjab submits that the first appeal of the petitioner dated 09.09.2020 (Annexure P-3) shall be considered and dealt with strictly in accordance with law within a period of three weeks and decision thereof would be communicated to the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned Deputy Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Punjab, the petition stands disposed of. However, it is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and therefore, the respondent-authorities would be at liberty to examine the appeal keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter accept or reject the same in accordance with law.
