Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Today, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners. On the last two dates of hearing, position was the same.

Through this petition, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail as they apprehend their implication in a false criminal case at the instance of respondent No.4.

In this case, learned State counsel has filed the reply, by way of an affidavit dated 02.12.2020 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dakha, District Ludhiana (Rural). The para No.5 of the said reply reads as under: -

“That petitioner No.1-Parminderpal Kaur and petitioner No.5-Manwinder Singh have been arrested in this case on 27.06.2020 and petitioner No.4 has been arrested on 06.07.2020 in this case. So, these petitioners may apply for regular bail to the learned trial Court under Section 437 Cr.P.C. or to the learned Session Court under Section 439 Cr.P.C. No case is registered against Dilawar Singh and Harinderpal Kaur, petitioners No.2 &3. In these circumstances, the petition filed by all the petitioners has become infructuous.

There is no merit in this petition and the same may be dismissed in the interest of justice.”

Since petitioners No.1 and 5 were arrested on 27.06.2020 and petitioner No.4 was also arrested on 06.07.2020 in this case and no case has been registered against petitioners No.2 and 3, the present petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
