Prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 318 dated 05.12.2017, under Sections 395 and 397 of IPC registered at Police Station Sector 9-A, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

FIR was registered on the complaint of one Vijay Kumar wherein he stated that his company provides ATM service to private banks. In Delhi NCR, ATM machine of Axis Bank is installed in Laxman Vihar, Phase 2, Gurugram. On the intervening night of 4/5.12.2017, ATM machine was stolen. At that time, an amount of Rs. 24,61,600/- was kept in ATM machine.

Learned counsel for petitioner has argued that petitioner is not named in FIR. He was implicated only on the disclosure statement of co accused Ishtak and Habib. Isthak and Habib have already been released on bail.

The investigation in case is complete. Challan has been filed. Petitioner is in custody since 11.09.2020.

Considering the aforesaid and without commenting

anything on merit of case and the fact that trial of case may take a long time, no useful purpose will be served by detaining petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of trial. Accordingly, petition is allowed. Petitioner Sahid @ Polo is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
