This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Ceriorari quashing the impugned order/reply dated 16.12.2020 passed/given by official respondent No.4 (Annexure P-18), with a further prayer to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to give the attested copies of the following documents, namely (i) copy of appointment order from current employer; (ii) copy of joining report from current employer; (iii) copy of relevant pages of service book (entries made of order of appointment, joining and medical examination); (iv) copy of medical examination conducted from the Government Hospital; and (v) NOC from current employer.

It has been pointed out by the counsel for the respondents that the petitioner is an employee of postal department, which is covered under the jurisdiction of Central Administrative Tribunal. The matter involved in the present petition is relating to one of the aspects of service of the petitioner because the above said documents were submitted by the petitioner for the purpose of the present employment only.

In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter any further. Hence, the present writ petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail his remedy before the Central Administrative Tribunal, in accordance with law.
