SANT PARKASH, J.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.74 dated 01.06.2020 registered under Sections 148/149/188/323/325/452/506 IPC and Section 3 of the SC/ST Act at Police Station Rozka Meo, District Mewat.

On 24.02.2021, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon order dated 27.08.2020 passed in CRM-M No.22765 of 2020 titled Satpal vs. State of Haryana and order dated 11.11.2020 passed in CRM-M No. 29756 of 2020 titled Sonu vs. State of Haryana.

Notice of motion for 18.05.2021.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 03.03.2021 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Upon instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the above-said order dated 24.02.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

Taking into consideration the totality of circumstances, the interim order dated 24.02.2021 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions as contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
