Case taken up through video conferencing.

Feeling aggrieved by her alleged maltreatment and harassment at the hands of her husband Karamjit Singh, arrayed as respondent No.4, petitioner – Kulwinder Kaur, aged about 24 years, resident of VPO Ganduan, Tehsil Lehra, District Sangrur is said to have moved a written complaint dated 2.12.2020 addressed to IGP, Patiala Zone, Patiala (respondent No.2), copy of endorsed to Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur (respondent No.3), copy of which is Annexure P1, however that complaint is not said to have evoked any

response. As such, she has filed the present criminal writ petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India for protection of her life and liberty.

Notice of motion to respondent No.1 to 3.

Mr.J.S. Ghuman, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur is directed to decide the representation dated 2.12.2020, copy Annexure P1.

Learned State counsel submits that the respondents No.1 to 3 would abide by any such order passed by this Court.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur to consider the representation Annexure P1 and to take necessary action in the matter, in accordance with law if it is so warranted by facts and circumstances of the case.
