The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 231 dated 03.12.2020 registered under Section 148, 149, 341, 379B, 427, 506 of IPC at Police Station Sanoli, District Panipat.

Prosecution in this case was launched on the submission of application by Ramdass son of Anup Singh wherein he alleged that on 02.12.2020, at about 10.00 PM, he was going to his village Sanoli Kalan from Panipat in his car Verna. When he reached near the village, on the way a car was coming from the front side and got stopped his car. From that car,

Visant son of Vinod Tyagi and four other boys alighted who were carrying Dandas and belts and started striking at the glass of his car and they also started beating him. They snatched the mobile phone from his hand and took away Rs. 700/- from his car. Vishant and other four boys are also stated that take out the weapons from the car and they will kill him. Accordingly, formal FIR was registered.

Along with this petition, affidavit of Iqbal Singh son of Ajit Singh (Annexure P-2) has been filed and as per the said affidavit, on 02.12.2020 the petitioner had gone to Haridwar on booking.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 11.01.2021.

Noticing the nature of allegation and his custody, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall not extend any threat and shall not influence any prosecution witnesses in any manner directly or indirectly.
