Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that it has already come on record that respondent No. 6 has embezzled an amount but no action is being taken either by the Society or by respondent No. 2 on the application preferred by the petitioners, who are the members of the Society. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in a totally illegal and arbitrary manner, an employee, against whom the allegations of embezzlement have been proved, is being allowed to continue though, an FIR against him for embezzlement of the amount has also been registered. Learned counsel further submits that their complaint/representation before respondent No. 2 dated 09.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) is also not bearing any result as the said complaint/representation is being kept pending by respondent No. 2 without any valid justification.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Rajni Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned State counsel submits that the representation dated 09.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioners before respondent No. 2 will be decided within a period of six weeks from the receipt of copy of this order, if not already decided.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the grievance of the petitioners as raised in the present writ petition has been redressed and petitioners do not wish to press this petition at this stage.
