After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court, to file a petition for regular bail before the learned trial Court and directions being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the same, as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.

2. The same is not opposed by learned State Counsel.

3. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is dismissed as withdrawn. Needless to mention, in case the petitioner moves a petition for regular bail before the learned trial Court, the learned trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
