Through this petition, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 05, dated 16.01.2020 under Sections 22 and 29 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Dharamgarh, Distirct Sangrur.

Vide order dated 12.02.2020, passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 12.02.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
