The petitioner is seeking a direction to the official respondents to look into the matter and take appropriate legal action against the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had married respondent No. 4 and he (respondent No. 4) had gone to Canada on the promise that he will call the petitioner. However, the petitioner was not called to Canada and the dowry and other articles of the petitioner have also been misappropriated by respondent No. 4 and his relatives. He also contends that the petitioner has sent representation (Annexure P2) in this regard to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali (respondent No. 2), but no action has been taken thereon.

Issue notice to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

Heard.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali (respondent No. 2) to look into the representation (Annexure P2) and take action in accordance with law.
