The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.08 dated 09.01.2020 under Sections 363 and 366A IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that on the direction of this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation. Apart from that, he submit that the matter stands compromised between the parties and the marriage that was performed between the petitioner and the daughter of the complainant has been accepted by both the families.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and that the matter has

been investigated.

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated and petitioner has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 03.03.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.
