Case taken up through Video Conferencing.

The petitioner-wife has filed the present petition seeking transfer of the divorce petition filed by the respondent from the Family Court, Ambala to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Yamuna Nagar.

Notice in the petition was issued but before the matter could be finally adjudicated upon, the respondent-husband filed an application, stating therein that he has no objection if the prayer made by the petitioner is accepted.

After considering the hardships of the petitioner-wife enumerated in the petition, viz. her minor daughter, who is living with her, pending litigation between the parties at Yamuna Nagar and her financial condition and in particular the consent by the respondent-husband, the petition for divorce bearing No.HMA-1072-2019 – *Dhruv Kohli vs. Garima* is ordered to be transferred from the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Ambala to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Yamuna Nagar.

Accordingly, the learned District Judge, Ambala, is directed to

send complete record of the abovesaid petition to the learned District Judge, Yamuna Nagar, at an early date but in any case within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The learned District Judge, Yamuna Nagar, is also directed either to decide the case himself or assign it to the learned court of competent jurisdiction, for an early decision, in accordance with law.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present transfer application stands disposed of, however, with no order as to costs.
