The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* directing the respondents to quash the impugned communication dated 25.01.2021 (Annexure P7) vide which the penal action is sought to be taken against the petitioners without any basis for recovery, for which, representations dated 17.12.2020 and 27.01.2021 (Annexures P-10 and P-11, respectively) have also been submitted before the respondent-authorities.
