1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.319 dated 27.10.2020, under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC (Section 201 IPC added on 24.10.2020 against the petitioner and Section 326 IPC was added against her son Jony and her father-in-law Ram Chander on 22.1.2021), registered at Police Station Sector 13-17, Panipat.

2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion on 25.2.2021, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, who is a lady, has falsely been implicated in the

present case and that in any case she is attributed simple injury with a stick.

Notice of motion for 08.07.2021.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Arresting/Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

3. Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Rajbir Singh has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court on 25.2.2021, the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation and that she is not wanted in any other case.

4. Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, particularly that the petitioner is a lady and she has already joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation and is also not wanted in any other case, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 25.2.2021 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
