The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.273 dated 04.12.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 66 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 24.02.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Charan Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above and considering the fact that the petitioner was granted the concession of interim bail about one and a half year ago and he has not misused the same during the intervening period, the present

petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 24.02.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
