The claim is for release of the ACP benefit, as per notification dated 03.11.2006. The perusal of the writ petition would go on to show that the petitioner had taken pre-mature retirement on 18.02.2009 as a Veterinary Officer and a representation has been filed on 07.10.2020. In these circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that there is an alternative efficacious remedy available to the petitioner to approach the Civil Court.

In view of above, this Court feels that it is not a case to exercise its extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. Thus, the petition is hereby dismissed. It is always open to the petitioner to seeks redressal of his grievance before an appropriate forum.
