Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.175 dated 22.10.2020 under Section 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 25.02.2021: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the deal of sale of the property was settled by one Avtar Singh, who has already effected a compromise with complainant-Dr. Deepali Khanna and has returned the entire money to her.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab, who is also appearing through video conferencing,

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accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has not disputed the aforesaid fact...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sartej Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation and challan stands presented.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 25.02.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
