This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

CM No.8903-CWP of 2021

Prayer in this application is for preponement of hearing of the writ petition, which is listed for hearing on 01.10.2021 and disposing of the same in view of the compromise arrived at between the petitioners and respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the respondents do not raise any objection for preponement of hearing of the matter.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, hearing of the writ petition is preponed from 01.10.2021 for today itself.

Application is accordingly disposed of.

CWP No.3898 of 2019

Prayer in the writ petition is for entrustment of investigation arising out of FIR No.13 dated 17.01.2019 under Sections 406/420 IPC, Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib to Central Bureau of Investigation as it is stated that free, fair and partial investigation is not accepted from the respondent police authorities. Subsequent prayer for monitoring of the investigation is also addressed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners and respondent No.4 submit that during the pendency of this writ petition, entire dispute being of civil and commercial nature has been amicably resolved between the parties and they want to put a quietus to the disputes and differences between them. The terms and conditions of the compromise have been reduced into writing on 01.12.2020 in the shape of a Compromise deed, a copy of which is attached as Annexure P17. It is further submitted that both the parties have decided to withdraw all litigations between them and not pursue the matter/s any further. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a separate petition for quashing of FIR No.13 dated 17.01.2019 under Sections 406/420 IPC, Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi shall be filed by the petitioners.

While reiterating the compromise, learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that the said respondent shall remain bound by the terms and

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conditions of the compromise and shall take all steps as may be required of him for facilitating quashing of the abovementioned FIR.

In this view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw this writ petition.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to file an appropriate petition to seek quashing of FIR No.13 dated 17.01.2019, under Sections 406/420 IPC, Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib, in accordance with law.
