The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.318 dated 08.10.2020, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 34 IPC (final report was filed on 22.12.2020 before the Illaqa Magistrate for the offence punishable under Sections 307, 323, 325, 341, 506, 34 IPC) registered at Police Station Uchana, district Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is attributed a *lathi* blow on the left elbow of the complainant. The petitioner is in custody for over 02 months and 23 days and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Ravinder, contends that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed. He, however, contends that *danda* has been recovered from the petitioner.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the above especially when a solitary injury on the non-vital part of the body of the complainant is attributed to the petitioner, he is in custody for almost 03 months, he is not involved in any other case, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
