1. Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

2. This second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 90 dated 07.09.2017, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala.

As per the allegations in the FIR, there was an incident on 05.09.2017 in which the accused have inflicted injuries to the complainant. The role attributed to the petitioner is that he got hold of the complainant. Petitioner was granted interim bail by the trial Court. He absented from appearance in Court on 19.08.2019. Petitioner was declared proclaimed offender on 12.02.2020. He was arrested on 07.03.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the non presence of the petitioner was due to communication gap and reasons beyond the control. He further submits that petitioner has mended his ways, he has already undergone almost one and half year after being the arrested. To establish his *bonafide*, petitioner offers to Rs.75,000/- in cash security with the trial Court, subject to outcome of the trial.

The petitioner was granted bail. He absented himself in the trial. He is already undergone one and half year thereafter, the offer made by the petitioner *prima facie* appears to be genuine. Petitioner is granted bail, subject to deposit of Rs.75,000/- with the trial Court. The amount deposited shall be subject of outcome of the trial, it shall be kept in an FDR in a Nationalized Bank. In case the petitioner fails to appear before the trial court as required, the amount would be forfeited.

Disposed of accordingly.
